Participation Guidelines for Youth and Parent/Guardian/Chaperone:

To qualify for entry into this fun, educational and motivational weekend program camp-in at the Will McLean Music Festival youth will agree to:

- 1) Take an active role in the various opportunities offered throughout the weekend according to their individual comfort level.
- 2) Attend the Young Performer's Showcase to support those who have been chosen to perform on the adult Azalea Stage on Saturday Afternoon.
- 3) Attend the MANDATORY Saturday Morning Meet and Greet Breakfast Meeting. (A Continental breakfast will be provided. Arrive no later than 9:45am.)
- 4) Be between the ages of 5 yrs and 23 yrs of age to participate unless: 1) If over 23 yrs, participating in a band with those who are younger. 2) Be an alumnus of the program and a volunteer mentor.
- 5) One parent/guardian/chaperone must be on the ground of the Ranch with their minor child(ren) at all times.

NOTE: Travel arrangements for arrival and departure will be taken into account wit the exception of the MANDITORY Meet and Greet Breakfast Meeting. Please advise the Program Director: Laura Jo Julian: LauraJulian.WillMcLean@gmail.com of your arrangements should there be changes other than what you put on your Registration Form. (See Link Below to Register.)

CAMPING GUIDELINES:

1) YMPC has it's own designated camping area at the Ranch. Any campers choosing NOT to stay in the YMPC area are on a First Come First Serve basis.

- Non-Electric Tent Camping in the YMPC area will be is being provided by the Will McLean Foundation for approved registered participants and volunteers for the year of 2025.
- 3) Electric Campsites are available for tents, RV's, Motor Homes, etc. at a rate of \$40/per night (Includes taxes) and paid for upon arrival at the front gate. It is recommended that you reserve a site within the YMPC as there no reserved sites outside of that area. Please fill out the information on your application as to your preference. (Link below.) The Program Director must be notified of any changes made prior to March 1st.
- 4) All campers will receive a printable ticket to give to the gate to help speed the process along. Once your registration is approved you will be sent your ticket.
- 5) Young Performer Showcase participants will pay for their campsites just like all the adult paid performers.
- 6) The location of the YMPC designated area is next to the fence just past the gate. You will need to text the Program Director upon arrival as sites are reserved. You will be provided with that phone number upon registration approval. Should you not be able to text, an approximation of your arrival can be emailed ahead of time so volunteers can be on the lookout for you.

GATE ENTRY GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS AND PERFORMERS:

- 1) Youth under 16 years of age have free entry.
- 2) Youth from 16 to 23 years of age will receive gate entry if they are registered as participants in the program.
- 3) Attendees over the age of 16 will pay for their festival passes if they are not participating in the program.
- 4) Two parents/guardians/legal chaperones will be allowed to attend the festival with the participant(s). All others will be required to purchase festival passes.
- 5) Young Performer Showcase award participants and their band members will receive one guest pass entry ticket each.
- 6) If over the age of 23 years, you must be an alumnus of the program as a volunteer mentor to receive entry into the festival and must have received prior approval by the Program Director.
- 7) The Entry Gate keeps a list of names of approved participants and performers and their guests. If you can not list the name on your registration or performer's application at this time they must be reported to the Program Director at LauraJulian.WillMcLean@gmail.com no later than February 20th of the current year.

8) This year you will receive a ticket ONE WEEK BEFORE THE FESTIVAL to be handed in to the gate to avoid long lines. Please print the ticket or present a cell phone picture of it when you arrive.

OPENING CEREMONY:

There is a long tradition of the YMPC participants performing the opening song, "This Land is Your Land" (Key G) from the Magnolia Stage (Main Stage) simultaneously with the other festival stages at 11:50am on Friday morning. If you'd like to be a part of the Opening Ceremony you must be next to the Shooting Star Stage no later than 10:15am to rehearse prior to performing. Please learn the song ahead of the rehearsal.

CLOSING FESTIVAL:

The YMPC is invited on the Magnolia stage to sing Will McLean's annual Closing Ceremony song, "Hold Back the Waters". (Videos are on Youtube of Will performing this song.) Should you need help with this send the Program Director an email.
